## **Dear Families**

The Enrichment Programme aims to offer our students experiences and activities that go beyond the curriculum. We want every individual to extend their skills and talents in a range of areas, and this booklet gives you an insight into the clubs and activities available to our students.

The Programme is part of the school week, taking place from 3:40pm to 5pm every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. All students are strongly encouraged to attend at least one of these sessions. Please find the form to complete on the back page.

Each activity runs for the duration of 2 modules, so students can make three choices over the course of the year. Whilst numbers are limited for some courses, we hope that these regular changes will allow every individual to try their first preference at some point. Some of the courses have accreditation attached to them; others will simply enrich your CV and any applications for education or employment placements.

At certain points in the year, small groups of students may be allocated tuition sessions in some subject areas as their needs are identified. If students are invited to these compulsory sessions, they will take priority over other enrichment activities.
