Dear parent,

We would like to take the opportunity to invite your child to a virtual **Sixth Form Induction Day** on **Tuesday 7th July** from **10:00am to 2:00pm**.

This will be an opportunity for students to experience a day in the life of a Sixth Former at UAE by attending live taster lessons in A Level and BTEC subjects, having a virtual tour of the sixth form, and joining Q&A sessions with the Sixth Form team as well as current Sixth Form students. They will also get the opportunity to find out more about the various Enrichment activities and support services available to them in Sixth Form. **If your child plans to attend UAE Sixth Form it is the expectation that they will attend the Induction Day.**

As school remains closed for the majority of students, the Induction Day will take place entirely online via Google Classroom with all live teaching and Q&A sessions taking place via Google Meets. All students attending the Induction Day will need internet access from 10:00am to approximately 2:00pm to attend the live sessions that will be taking place. They will also need to be logged into their school email accounts to join the live sessions.

We will send through a timetable for the Induction Day and guidance on using Google Meets to all parents and students via email in the coming days.

The Induction Day will be a really exciting and beneficial experience for students to get a taste of Sixth Form life at UAE, to become more familiar with the Sixth Form team and subject teachers, and get a sense of what a Sixth Form lesson is like. We are all really looking forward to welcoming students, both those staying on from UAE and those joining us from other schools, into our Sixth Form and supporting them through this exciting next phase in their academic life.
